

ORCA E-Snipe PYLON RACE

THE AIRPLANE:

- Stock ESnipe (Foam ARF available from John Castleman)
- May have ailerons and/or rudder. Either rudder or ailerons or both.
- Any 3 cell LIPO battery may be used.
- Any prop may be used.
- Motor must be a 400 size, weighing no more than 60 grams (as stated in motor spec, or as weighed without mount) which is 2.12 ounces.
- Use paint or covering or decals to make your plane unique, especially the vertical stabilizer and wing. Go nuts!

THE RACE:

- ESnipe must ROG on signal from starter.
- Must fly at least as far as two pylons placed at each end of runway.
- You must complete 5 laps around this course to complete a heat.
- Each flyer will fly four heats during a race day, with a max of four planes in any one heat.
- There will be a one lap penalty for cutting the pylon (not going far enough).
- Two cuts and you are DQ'd, or no points earned in that heat.
- One point is awarded for each flyer in the heat. In a four plane heat, first place gets 4 points, second place gets 3 points, third place will receive 2 points, fourth place will receive 1 point. Zero points if DQ'd or if do not finish 5 laps.
- Pilots will be assigned to races at the beginning of the day, using a matrix similar to that done by the glow GutterSnipes.

THE SCHEDULE:

Race day will be held once per month, starting 15 minutes after the end of the Slow Stick races. Racers will arrive no later than 9:30 am. Race season is usually February through November.

For a race season, each pilot's total score will be the sum of the points from that pilot's best 6 days.

In case of rainout, that month's race will be cancelled.

Awards will be given at the end of the season at the discretion of the race organizer. Please make sure the race organizer has your email address. **HAVE FUN!**
